## WINTRUST BANK COMING TO MAYWOOD

Proviso Community Bank, a branch of Wintrust Financial Corporation, recently signed a lease to move into two units inside of Maywood Plaza, 1109-1123 West Madison Street. The move comes six years after Wintrust tried to establish a presence on the corner of 1st Avenue and Lake Street.

The move to Maywood comes after Wintrust's attempt to enter the Village in 2013 fell through. A vote to authorize the vacating of an alley near the development site, which was considered to be critical to the development and required a supermajority, failed to pass.

Christopher J. Parker, who also serves as President of the Bellwood Chamber of Commerce and former member of the Maywood Chamber of Commerce, will also serve as the Bank's commercial lender. Parker added that the Maywood Branch would complement the services and products offered by the Proviso Community branch in Stone Park, which Wintrust acquired in 2014. Jose A. Villa, who manages the Stone Park Branch, is a member of the Maywood Chamber Board.
